



Are my Ohio elected officials Pro-Choice?

NARAL Pro-Choice Ohio wants you to be informed about your representatives here in Ohio. This Senate scorecard will help you to determine if your Ohio Senator is Pro-Choice, Anti-Choice or somewhere in-between.

The scores in this scorecard are based on how the representative voted on Sub. HB 239. **Sub. H.B. 239, Abortion Funding Restrictions** took the current Ohio Department of Health rules about state funding for abortion services and codified them into the Ohio Revised Code. These rules include a prohibition on state funds, either through state employee health insurance or through state Medicaid money, being used for abortion services unless the abortion is necessary to save the woman's life or the woman was a victim of rape or incest.

In addition to their votes, co-sponsorships of reproductive rights related bills are indicated by a number following their score. A number one (1) indicates co-sponsorship of H.B. 239 (see above for full description), a number two (2) indicates co-sponsorship of H.B. 228 the Ohio Abortion Ban, which would have outlawed ALL abortions in Ohio without exceptions. Both of these bills were opposed by NARAL Pro-Choice Ohio. A number three (3) indicates co-sponsorship of the H.B. 588 Ohio Prevention First Act, a number four (4) indicates co-sponsorship of H.B. 582 Contraceptive Equity and a number five (5) indicates co-sponsorship of H.B. 587 Emergency Contraception in the Emergency Room for Sexual Assault victims. All three of these bills were supported by NARAL Pro-Choice Ohio.

A score of **100%** means that the representative voted **pro-choice**, and a score of **0%** means the member voted **anti-choice**. A score of DNV indicates that the member did not vote and therefore a score could not be calculated.
